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Introduction

Well drilling project for a geothermal purpose
requires a

UNIQUE PERMIT

Unique permit = environmental permit +
construction permit

Legal basis

Environmental permit

Decree of 11 March 1999 (MB : 8 June 1999).

Orders of the walloon Government of 4 July 2002 :

- classification of installations and activities,
- procedures and several measures for execution,
- general conditions.

Construction permit

CWATUP : article 84, §1st, 1°

Classification

Order of the walloon Government of 4 July 2002
fixing the types of projects requiring an impact
study and the installations and activities requiring
a permit - Annex I.

45.12.01. : well drilling for nuclear waste storage or
for geothermal purposes

45.12.02. : well drilling for water production purpose

Class 2

Classification

41.00.03.02. : installation(s) for water production and/or underground water treatment, non-drinkable and not used for human consumption, production capability $> \geq 10$ m³/day and $> < 3\ 000$ m³/year, and $< \text{or } \leq 10\ 000\ 000$ m³/year : **class 2**

41.00.04. : installations for underground water artificial recharge or such attempts: **class 1 (EIE)**

Procedure

Order of the walloon Government of 4 July 2002 related to the procedure and application of the 11 March 1999 Decree related to the environmental permit.

Procedure : submission submission of permit request to the local administration.

- **Water well – 2 steps permit :**

1) Limited time permit for the duration of well drilling, casing and pumping tests : annex I (general), XVIII (drilling) and III (water catchment) ».

2) Water catchment permit : annex I and III .

Procedure

Order of the walloon Government of 4 July 2002 related to the procedure and application of the 11 March 1999 Decree related to the environmental permit.

Procedure :

- Re-injection well – permit related to the production well permit : annex I, XVIII and VIII (injection).
- Well for installation of geothermal equipment : annex I and XVIII (drilling).

Sectorial conditions

Well drilling and equipment for underground water production purpose - 45.12.02.

An Order project of the walloon Government defining sectorial conditions was written by the Groundwater Direction in 2009. Promulgation expected in 2010.

Work basis :

French norm NF X10-999 April 2007 – Water wells and geothermal drilling.

Sectorial conditions

Well drilling and equipment for vertical geothermal installations - 45.12.01.

An Order project of the walloon Government defining sectorial conditions should be written by the Groundwater Direction in 2010. Promulgation expected in 2011.

Current work basis :

- the project of the sectorial conditions related to the well drilling and equipment for groundwater production purpose;
- the french norm « Geothermy »; publication is expected for June 2010.

Sectorial conditions

Installation(s) for water production and/or groundwater treatment - 41.00.02. and 41.00.03.

Orders of the walloon Government of 12 February 2009 defining :

- sectorial conditions (class 2) - MB 25/3/09
- integral conditions (class 3) - MB 12/3/09.

Installations for the artificial recharge or such attempts of groundwater :

No sectorial conditions.

Drillers certification

Under study by the Groundwater Direction

Objective: to limit the access of drilling activity to qualified companies, which should be constrained to use appropriate equipment and should be concerned by the respect of environment preservation rules.
